




County First 5 Commissions and Private Partnerships

As resources diminish, county First 5 commissions are increasingly reaching out to foundations and other private sector partners to assist in promoting optimal child health and development, enhancing family functioning, and improving the systems that serve young children and their families. The following chart provides a snapshot of private sector funds leveraged by a sample of commissions in two regions – Southern California and the Bay Area -- during the last two years. *(Please note, these are solely the dollars obtained as part of specific commission initiatives that are tracked by the respective commissions; individual service providers often leverage significantly more based on their receipt of First 5 funds, but those funds are not tracked by commissions as a matter of course. Thus these data underreport the full extent of private leveraging.)*

Since Fiscal Year 2008-09, 14 Southern California and Bay Area First 5 commissions leveraged approximately \$74.6 million private dollars, representing 56.7% of the more than \$131 million committed to specific joint public-private initiatives.



Efforts funded in coordination with the private sector include:

Child development: Pre-math and pre-literacy programs; summer kindergarten readiness programs; family literacy projects; enhancement of preschool and early education; parent outreach projects

Child health: Access to health insurance and health care providers; oral health education, treatment, and prevention (including infrastructure for fluoridation); developmental screenings and access to services; early childhood behavioral health services

Family functioning: Child abuse prevention; emergency housing; targeted services for homeless children; expansion of 2-1-1 service; parenting education for at-risk families, including victims of trauma or parent/caregiver depression; customization and expanded distribution of the Kit for New Parents

Improving Systems: Capacity building efforts, particularly for programs targeting under-served populations; assistance with non-profit management; dissemination of information about evidence-based and best practices; facilities development; 0-5 asset and data mapping; coordinating programs across agencies and professions; and systems planning efforts
